- The London Care Record is an information-sharing platform integrated into clinical systems across London's health and care economy.
- It is supporting the transformation of care pathways across the following care settings:





How the London Care Record and the OneLondon programme is structured

Level **Description** Sharing of information. Provides a portal or integration that can be accessed through existing IT systems. Allows <u>unstructured</u> information and image / report sharing. **Structured** collation and presentation of information. Provides the ability to share data between care settings, trend results and is the platform for analytics. Patient access to their information. Allows the patient to access and contribute towards their patient record. Supports bi-directional communication with care providers.




Our current technology landscape

Description Level **Cerner - Health Information Exchange (HIE)** Provides the portal and the ability to exchange raw images, reports and pathology results across London. London Health Data Strategy (Microsoft Azure, SQL, Snowflake) Provide a structured repository for information, enabling results to be collated and examined consistently for the purposes of analytics and research. **Patient Knows Best NHS App / Patient Access Epic - MyChart** Provides the ability for patients to view and access their appointment information, request repeat prescriptions and communicate with their care provider(s).




- From a starting point in April 2021 where 33K unique users collectively viewed 609K records, the London Care record had its highest ever number of views in November totalling 1,240,471
- The cumulative views since 31 March 2020, when we first went live, have now exceeded
 million.

The London Care Record

- Is read-only and integrates using information feeds from clinical 'direct care' environments.
- Provides the window to other services such as the Urgent Care Plan.
- Does not contain structured and curated data and therefore is not a data platform.

The Urgent Care Plan

- Provides a read and write platform for accessing and contributing information to the record.
- Can feed the London Care Record (LCR) so that records are made available at the point of care.
- Has capabilities to develop other solutions as long as data structures are OpenEHR compliant.
- Is an ecosystem platform and requires short, medium and long-term commitment by leadership.
- Can consume structured information so that datasets are ingested into the system, reducing transcription challenges.
- It is important we are clear what the principles are for UCP because it should not become 'everything to all'

Enabling personalised care and support plans to be shared digitally

- The London Universal Care Plan (UCP) is a **dynamic**, **integrated**, **digital** care plan that is accessible to all health and care professionals across London.
- Communicates:
 - Personal information e.g about me, preferences and wishes.
 - Clinical recommendations e.g treatment escalation, emergency treatment plans.
 - Care plans can be continuously co-created by any user in London.
- Role Based access determines the edit rights:
 - 'About me' information is editable by non-clinicians and clinicians.
 - Clinical information and treatment escalation plans are editable by clinicians.
 - Urgent care services (999, 111) have read only access.
- Easy process to start a care plan and import a patient's demographics from PDS.
- Aligns to PRSB standards, prints standard national forms e.g. DNACPR red boarder form.
