

















1. We want to keep enabling the enablers






Council progress

'High priority' actions are items rated 'high' for:

- Backups
- Logging
- Multi-factor authentication
- Use of NCSC Active Cyber Defence tools

Taking stock: the Local Digital Declaration

- The Local Digital Declaration is the manifesto of the Local Digital team.
- 288 councils have signed it, committing to "design services that best meet the needs of citizens" that "protect citizens' privacy and security", while "break[ing] dependence on inflexible and expensive technology"

Our eight initial partner councils



What the councils will be working on during the pilot

All partner councils will:


- baseline current digital and cyber maturity, and agree a plan with DLUHC to make and evidence improvements
- start work towards adopting and meeting the <u>Cyber Assessment Framework for Local</u>
 <u>Government</u>
- identify at least one key service area to transform through migrating away from legacy technology (the partner councils can choose which service to focus on)
- identify the most significant organisational and cultural barriers to reform and create a plan to fix those
- take part in training and/or mentoring for a range of council staff
